RESOLUTION APPROVING USE OF NEWSPAPER TO PUBLISH LEGAL NOTICES

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF DELPHI, INDIANA, APPROVING THE USE OF THE LAFAYETTE JOURNAL & COURIER TO PUBLISH LEGAL NOTICES

WHEREAS, the City Council of Delphi, Indiana recognizes that certain municipal meetings and actions shall be published in a newspaper when required by Indiana Law;

WHEREAS, the Carroll County Comet ceased publication as of January 1, 2024, and no other newspaper or locality newspaper is published within the City of Delphi or within Carroll County where the City of Delphi is located;

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2024, the Carroll County Commissioners moved to use the Lafayette Journal & Courier published in adjacent Tippecanoe County to publish legal notices for the Carroll County Government;

WHEREAS, the City Council of Delphi, Indiana desires to use the Lafayette Journal & Courier to publish legal notices to be consistent with the Carroll County Government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Delphi, Indiana that:

Section 1. The Journal & Courier, Lafayette, Indiana, shall be used to publish legal notices for the City of Delphi government agencies, boards, and commissions.

Section 2. In the event that the Carroll County Government chooses to cease using the Journal & Courier, Lafayette, Indiana, and to use a different newspaper from another adjacent county, the City of Delphi will align to using the same newspaper as the Carroll County Government.

Section 3. In the event a Carroll County newspaper of general circulation qualifies under Indiana law for legal publication, the preferred publication shall be deemed to be the Carroll County newspaper, as required by Indiana law (Indiana Code Title 5, Article 3).
