## BOARD OF WORKS AUGUST 2, 2010 6:00 P.M.

Mayor Randy Strasser opened the meeting.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Unsafe properties update given by Mayor. Kurtis has done the title searches and we will proceed. Letters will be going to three property owners.

BZA has given Matt Zook a permit and an easement is recorded. Mr. Zook appeared before the Board of Works requesting water and sewage hook up. Mr. Zook was reminded that he would need an excavation permit. Brian Garrison made a motion approving utility hook up. Randy Strasser gave a second. Motion carried.

The issue brought to the Board of Works by Mr. Vern Hinkle in regards to making an exception to our curb and sidewalk ordinance will be taken to the Common Council for review.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Anita Force, Superintendent of Parks, appeared before the Board of Works with a request to sell 6 to 7 walnut trees. Some of these trees are in a position to cause damage to our buildings. Anita has received two bids. One of the bids is for \$4,660.00. They will provide proof of insurance and a contract will be issued. They will pay for the trees before they cut. There will be other ongoing expenses with tree removal and replacement in the parks and the selling of the walnut trees would enable for more to be done. Brian Garrison made the motion to approve the sale of the walnut trees. Randy Strasser gave a second. Motion carried.

Mayor Strasser would like for Kurtis Fouts to send letters and proceed with collection of unpaid hanger rentals.

Three quotes had been received for the Stone Barn. Mayor Strasser went back to two of the bidders to produce bids reflecting the same work.
