## **Gun Permits**

## INDIANA CONCEALED CARRY HANDGUN LICENSE

Below are the requirements that must be met to apply on-line for the Indiana State Police Firearms Concealed Carry Weapon Permit for a handgun license.

- 1. You must live within the city limits of Delphi. If you live outside the city limits you must apply with the agency of that jurisdiction.
- 2. If you have a current Handgun License, you may apply within **180 days** of your present expiration date. If your current license is within 30 days of its expiration date, the existing date, the existing license is automatically extended upon approval by the Chief of Police. Once approved, your copy of the initial application for renewal is to be carried with your present permit until you receive the permit from the Indiana State Police. Every initial application for any handgun license shall be granted or rejected within 60 days after the application is filed with the Delphi Police Department.
- 3. You must be at least 18 years of age.
- 4. You must complete the application on line at http://aries.in.gov/Firearms/Permit.aspx, answering in full each and every question/inquiry.
- 5. A box will pop up and ask for the county to which you are applying. Choose Carroll County from the list of counties. Then proceed with filling out the state form. Submitting false information or deliberate omissions may be grounds to deny the approval of your application.
- 6. Once application is submitted on line, you must set up an appointment for Gun Permit Fingerprinting. Your Indiana State Police fee will be paid at L-1 along with their fee for processing your fingerprints. Contact L-1 for method of payment.

- 7. After submission of your firearms application on-line, and you live inside the "city" limits, your next step along with L-1 is to pay your local fee at the Delphi Police Department, located at 201 South Union Street Delphi, Indiana, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (excluding holidays). Wednesday's 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary. If you were born outside of the United States, but you are a US citizen, provide a copy of your US Passport to DPD. This will assist Homeland Security to justify your citizenship.
- 8. The DPD Local Application Fee is due once your application has been submitted on-line. This fee must be made by Cash, Money Order or Certified Check and should be made payable to City of Delphi. Your Indiana driver's license and or identification card must have your current residence registered with the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicle. You will also be required to complete at Request for Criminal History Records form, which allows for a background check to be completed on you.

All fees that are listed under "DPD Local .Application Fee" should have payment made out to City of Delphi

All fees that are listed under "Indiana State Police Fee" should have payment made out to State of Indiana.

- 10. Your handgun application will be held on-line by the Indiana State Police for 120 days.
- 11. Indiana law requires an investigation into you criminal history records.
- 12. Once your fee has been paid at L-1 and EPD, your license when approved or disapproved by ISP, will be sent to the address indicated on your application within "4" weeks.
- 13. The Delphi Police Department can be contacted at 765-564-3841 Monday Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

- 14. When traveling out of the State of Indiana, check on-line with National Rifle Association (NRA) for confirmation of the states that recognize the Indiana Concealed Carry Weapon Permit.
