Stellar Homeowner Repair Program to be Expanded

Delphi, IN – December 20, 2013 – The City of Delphi today announced that applications are being accepted for the second phase of the Owner Occupied Repair program. In this phase, the area of eligibility has expanded to include much of the City north of Deer Creek.

“After the first phase, we heard a lot of interest in expanding the program to make more people eligible,” said Mayor Randy Strasser. “Many more residents can now make long needed repairs to their properties at no cost to them.”

These grant funds do not require a local match by the property owner. Examples of work that can be performed include roofs, doors, windows, furnaces, siding and related work.

To be considered for the program, property owners must first submit an application to the city. Applications can be picked up at City Hall, or on the City website at www.cityofdelphi.org. The property owner must live in the home, meet income requirements, and live within the eligible area.

A public informational meeting has been scheduled for January 16, 2014 at 7:00pm at the Wabash and Erie Canal Center. Interested residents can find out details of the program, and pick up an application at the event.
