

City to Host Public Open House to Update Community on Stellar Communities Projects

Delphi, IN – July 26, 2012 – August will be a busy month for Delphi Stellar Communities projects and there are a number of opportunities available for the public to have questions answered and learn more detailed information on the future project plans. The City of Delphi will host an open house to update the community on its Stellar Communities projects. The event will be held at the Wabash and Erie Canal Conference Center on Tuesday, August 21, 2012 from 5-6 pm.

“The open house will be a great opportunity for the community to see what progress has been made since May’s Stellar Communities announcement,” said Mayor Strasser.

There will also be two formal public hearings related to project specific grant applications. The formal hearings are scheduled for Monday, August 6, 2012, at the Delphi City Building (Upstairs) in the Council Room. A hearing related to the grant funding application for Downtown Façade Improvements will begin at 6:00 and a hearing related to the grant application for the Delphi Opera House Renovations will begin at 6:15pm.
