The Indiana Commission on Local Government Reform produced a report in 2007 titled *Streamlining Local Government*. One of the 27 recommendations in the report is the elimination of township government. This topic has been discussed in past state legislative sessions and will likely be an important topic in next year's General Assembly.
