



The **Delphi Municipal Airport** is a thriving, growing facility serving the city of Delphi, Indiana, and surrounding areas including Carroll County, Lafayette/West Lafayette - home of Purdue University, and the Indiana Beach resort area of Monticello. It is located at 8296 W. Division Line Road south of Delphi, between CR 800 W and 900 W. It is home to about 25 aircraft and includes an office and lounge area as well as a 2,900-foot paved runway. For a brief respite the administration building is always available with a beverage machine, restroom and comfortable chairs. First developed in 1969, this local General Aviation airport came about through the inspiration of local businessmen and farmers who understood the importance of air transportation to rural areas and growing small town communities. In the early 1980s the Delphi Board of Aviation Commissioners began boosting visibility of the airport in the public eye, and by the end of the 20th century with the help of Airport Entitlement funding, began making needed improvements.
