

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

JUNE 28, 2018

WORK SESSION

9:00 A.M.

Mayor Shane Evans opened the meeting and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Karyl Traeger and Dick Bradshaw, BOW members were present along with Mayor Evans.

Mayor Evans opened the Public Hearing for 922 Samuel Milroy Road with Chapter 94 Weeds.

Mayor Evans introduced Mandy Green, property owner, and asked her to explain her objection to the bill she received. Mrs. Green stated they had been gone for the winter and did not receive notice as required per ordinance. Upon their return, she found a note on her front door. Mrs. Green also stated herbs had been mowed off and trees trimmed. Mrs. Green also felt 5 hours was too much as she could mow her front section in 20 minutes.

Mayor Evans stated ordinance 94.03 requires notice to abate is required with 1st class mail. A letter was sent on May 11th. In 10 days the City can come in, post notice and mow.

Aaron Lyons explained the total of 5 hours comes from Aaron and 2 of his men working on the first day. Trees did have to be trimmed in order to mow. On the first day the bush hog was used as grass and weeds were at a height of 3 feet. On the second day two men went back and picked up the branches and finished.

Leanne checked with Marilyn and the original letter mailed on the 11th of May had been returned and the post office had stamped vacant instead of forwarding.

Dick Bradshaw felt it would be fair to cut the bill in half and Karyl Traeger agreed. Mr. and Mrs. Green also agreed with this amount. Mayor Evans stated he will rebill the Green with the correct amount of two hundred fifty dollars.

Public hearing closed.

The members discussed the meeting held on the evening of the 28th on water issues and possible solutions. Lots of thoughts and concerns were brought up. Short term fix versus long term is the first main concern. The other solution with Teays River is best but also the most expensive. Dick stated it is necessary to come up with priorities and costs and time frame and then take to the council.

Dick Bradshaw made the motion to adjourn. Second by Karyl Traeger. Motion carried.
