Members Dick Bradshaw, Shane Evans, and Anita Werling were in attendance.



Projects included: a curb/sidewalk plan with 100% city share, elevator, code enforcer, additional trees, additional officer, additional laborer, quiet crossings, viaduct improvements, parking downtown, alley beautification, and green/ecofriendly house. The Board also discussed the surplus in EDIT and identified residential development and hotel attraction as two possible projects if there were an additional appropriation.
