Spencer Kingery and Anita Werling were present; Kamron Yates was absent.

Minutes of the December 29, 2021, meeting were presented. The minutes were accepted as presented.

Claims totaling \$ 336,785.05 were presented for approval. Spencer Kingery moved to approve the claims. Second by Anita Werling. The claims were approved. (2-0)

Inger Cowan presented a plan for a Mardi Gras Parade on Saturday, February 26 at 12:00 p.m. The proposed route of the parade would be the same as the Christmas Parade: forming at the parking lot of The Sanctuary, west on Monroe to Market, one block south to Franklin, east on Franklin to Wilson, west of Wilson to Monroe. That Saturday will be the “Do it in Delphi” third-Saturday event as well as a Mardi Gras Ball at the Delphi Opera House in the evening. The organizing group is encouraging local businesses to participate by offering Mardi Gras and New Orleans themed food, crafts, and other merchandise. It is hoped that this will become an annual event. Spencer Kingery moved to approve temporary closing of the streets to accommodate the parade. Second by Anita Werling. Motion carried. (2-0)

There being no other business, Spencer Kingery moved to adjourn at 5:23 p.m. Second Anita Werling. Motion carried. (2-0)
