

BOARD OF WORKS & PUBLIC SAFETY  
July 17, 2023 – 5:15 PM

Mayor Anita Werling opened the meeting at 5:15 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Leanne Aldrich called the roll. Present were Breanna Maxwell, and Mayor Werling. Spencer Kingery was absent.

Minutes of the July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023 meeting were presented for review. Breanna Maxwell moved to approve. Second by Mayor Werling. The minutes were approved as read.

Claims totaling \$417,802.17 were presented. Breanna Maxwell moved to approve the claims. Second by Mayor Werling. No questions were asked. Motion carried. (2-0)

Other Business

JT Doane presented a modified request from the Delphi Main Street organization to close some downtown streets for the Old Settlers Festival scheduled for August 10 – 13. The request included shutting down the 100 block of West Franklin Street, half of the 100 block of East Franklin, and half of the 100 block of South Market Streets beginning Tuesday, August 8 after 5:00 p.m. The retail side only of the 100 block of South Washington would remain open for Wednesday business hours and would close after 5:00 p.m. for the duration of the festival. All streets would reopen by 8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 14. Breanna Maxwell moved to approve the plan. Second by Mayor Werling. Motion carried. (2-0)

Jeremy Sterrett requested to hook up to city sewer services for a building to be construction on a parcel adjacent to the Delphi Animal Hospital. Sterrett presented the plan set for the building. A bathroom and utility sink would be the only waste from the building. Sterrett knew he would be required to pay a monthly fee for the service and will fill out the required paper work when the building is completed. Breanna Maxwell moved to approve the sewer hook up. Second by Mayor Werling. Motion carried. (2-0)

A request from Amber Merchant was presented to locate a dumpster at 209 S. Monroe while moving. Breanna Maxwell moved to approve with the preference being to place the dumpster in the alley adjacent to the property if possible; but, if not possible, it could be placed in the street in front of the house. Second by Mayor Werling. Motion carried. (2-0)

Miscellaneous Business.


No comments or requests from board members or Clerk-Treasurer Aldrich.
