

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING

June 17, 2024 – 5:30PM

Second Floor, City Building, 201 S. Union Street

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Spencer Kingery, Breanna Maxwell, and Mayor Yates.

The minutes of the June 3, 2024 meeting were presented for review. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve by Spencer Kingery second by Breanna Maxwell. Minutes were approved as read and carried. (3-0)

The next order of business were regular claims for June 17, 2024 totaling \$1,150,111.72. Motion to accept the claims made by Spencer Kingery, second by Breanna Maxwell. Mayor Yates stated the amounts were higher this month due to 3 SRF payments. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Dustin Johnson with DAA was present to request usage of Riley Park for a community outreach cookout that would include games, food, etc. The date for the request is July 20, 2024 from 12-5pm. He stated there would be music with speakers/sound system by Kyle Knoth. The board confirmed there would be no softball tourney hosted during that time. Motion to approve park usage was made by Spencer Kingery, second by Breanna Maxwell. Motion carried and passed (3-0).

Frontier Communications was present to request permission/permits for cut road for installation of the new fiber optics provided by them for 316 N. Market St. and 310 E. Franklin St. Most of the work would be overhead processes and if there would be conflict with Broadband, Frontier would be responsible to move the fiber at their cost. JT Doane stated there would be tack meetings to discuss any issues with the process. Motion to approve cut road permits was made by Spencer Kingery, second by Breanna Maxwell. Motion carried and passed (3-0).

New Business:

Mayor Yates stated there was a Water Loss Audit and Validation agreement from BF&S. The audit would satisfy the requirements of Indiana Codes. Motion to approve the agreement made by Breanna Maxwell, second by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed (3-0).




Public Comment.
