

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING
February 18, 2025 – 5:30PM

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Mayor Yates, Breanna Maxwell, and Spencer Kingery.

The minutes of February 3, 2025 meeting were presented for review. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve minutes as read by Spencer Kingery seconded by Breanna Maxwell. Minutes were approved as read and carried. (3-0)

Mayor Yates announced that Bill Schock was presented with a key to the city and a proclamation was read in honor of his 60 years of service to the fire department on February 8, 2025.

Broadway Broadband has reported that all underground North side has been completed with a spot or two that may need to be added, but they are done for the most part. They are currently installing the aerial portion on the North side and hope to have it done in the next 2 weeks. They have started calling customers on the North side to install drops. South side of Delphi is constructed and is connecting customers. Current customer count is 178/462 houses on the South side.




