
WHEREAS, Federal law requires that all participating communities adopt an updated floodplain management ordinance in order to qualify for the National Flood Insurance Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Delphi is a participating community with Carroll County, and must adopt an identical ordinance,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Delphi, Indiana, that:


The City of Delphi, Indiana, hereby adopts in total, the Carroll County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance attached as Exhibit A.




