

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 8

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING PARKING AGAINST THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, Indiana Code Section 9-21-16-7 provides vehicles stopped or parked upon a roadway where there is an adjacent curb must be stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of the vehicle parallel with and within twelve (12) inches of the right-hand curb;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code does not regulate the general action of parking against the flow of traffic;

WHEREAS, other municipalities within the State of Indiana regulate parking against the flow of traffic;

WHEREAS, parking against the flow of traffic is a concern of public safety and visual clearance.

WHEREFORE, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Delphi, Indiana the Code of Ordinance be amended as follows:

Section 1. Amend Chapter 71 to include the following:

§ 71.16 PARKING VEHICLES FACING ONCOMING TRAFFIC

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle or other vehicle along the side of any street so that the vehicle faces oncoming traffic from the nearest lane of travel.

Section 2. Amend the Schedule of the Ordinance Violation Bureau to include the following:

ORD 71.16	Parking Vehicles Facing Oncoming Traffic	\$15.00

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor. Previous ordinances in conflict therewith are hereby revoked.
