**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT**  
**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF DELPHI, INDIANA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL**  
**OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE STATE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE FUND AND ADDRESSING**  
**RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Delphi, Indiana recognizes the need to maintain the wastewater infrastructure to serve residents, businesses, and industry in the City of Delphi and immediate area;

WHEREAS, the City of Delphi has engaged Butler, Fairman & Seufert to conduct a Wastewater Systems analysis for long-range planning to meet community needs;

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly via HEA 1001 (2021), has allocated \$100 Million of federal Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to the Indiana Finance Authority (IFA) to provide grant funding to Indiana utilities for wastewater, drinking water, and stormwater projects that either protect or improve public health or water quality;

WHEREAS, the goal of the SWIF program will be to finance projects that protect and improve public health and water quality, satisfy a regional solution, and provide substantial rate relief to Indiana utility customers most in need. The funds will be provided in the form of co-funded grants to communities;

WHEREAS, the City of Delphi has Wastewater capital funds on hand to co-fund an awarded SWIF Grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Delphi, Indiana that:

**Section 1.** The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for the SWIF program utilizing data provided by Butler, Fairman & Seufert and with assistance from K-IRPC for grant funding to address wastewater needs to improve stability and reliability of the treatment plant.

**Section 2.** The City Council of Delphi, Indiana hereby commits one-third (1/3) of the project cost using requisite local funds up to a maximum amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to co-fund the project submitted in the SWIF application.

Adopted by the City Council of Delphi, Indiana this 14<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2021 at 6:00 PM local time.


